

Art Guidelines

In order to submit art to the contest, please make sure to include the following on the back of the submission:

- The name of the student.
- Grade level of the student,
- The teacher's name and email
- Home address of the student, and
- Parent contact information (phone and email if the parents have email).

The deadline to submit the students' art is **Monday, April 2nd by 4pm**. Please leave the art submissions in the front office and we will pick them up directly from your school.

For the 2018 Linda Vista Multi-Cultural Fair the theme is "Our Stories" and we are celebrating the story about Linda Vista becoming the community we know and love today.

The Art Prompt is:

Think about what makes Linda Vista a community and how you/your family became members of this community. What is your connection to the Linda Vista community? Describe if you arrived to Linda Vista a long time ago or recently and if you are the third, fourth generation living here. How does your story or your family's story add to the collective Linda Vista story?

The art can be either portrait or landscape and any medium the student chooses, the size is regular printing paper – 8.5 x 11.

Students who participate in the Art contest must be in 2^{nd} 3^{rd} 4^{th} or 5^{th} grade. The Art will be judged by Members of the Linda Vista Multicultural Fair Board.

Every student who enters the contest is invited to be a part of the parade. Trophies must be displayed at the student's school.
